

Terms and Conditions

- Paws Spooktacular is a mass participation event and all walkers will be starting the walk together. We anticipate over 200 dogs taking part and therefore we ask that only friendly and well behaved dogs sign up.
- All dogs must remain on leads throughout the walk and humans must pick up after their dogs.
- All doggie entrants must get a human to enter them into the Paws Spooktacular, online or complete and sign a paper registration form.
- All dogs must be joined by a human for the Paws Spooktacular.
- Accompanying humans must be over 18 and responsible for their dog at all times.
- Children are welcome but must be accompanied by an adult.
- There route is 3km and is suitable for vaccinated puppies, older dogs and anyone who can walk a minimum of 3km.
- If you or your dog have a medical condition which could be affected by exercise, please obtain your vets and/or doctor's approval before participation.
- Humans must wear sensible footwear and take care at all times.

Entry fee

- The entry fee is £5 per dog. There is no fee for human companions.
- The non-refundable entry fee is to cover the cost of administration and resources for the Paws Spooktacular
- We do ask your dog to raise a sponsorship target of £25 per family. Every pound raised will help us continue to provide the vital services within Countess Mountbatten Hospice and the Community.
- Each dog entered into the Paws Spooktacular will receive a Halloween collar charm on the day of the walk.
